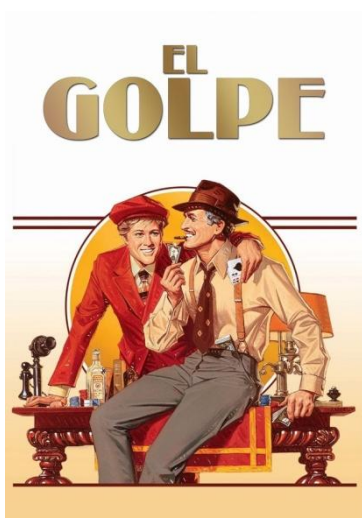


The man who loved dogs / Leonardo Padura
