


Armentrout, Jennifer L. White Hot Kiss (Dark Elements 1)


Weir, Andy Project Hail Mary


Daughter of Smoke and Bone 1

Now the doors to Elsewhere are closing, and Karou must choose between the safety of her human life and the dangers of a war-ravaged world that may hold the answers she has always sought.








ANTHONY TROLLOPE He Knew He Was Right








Hadfield, Chris
