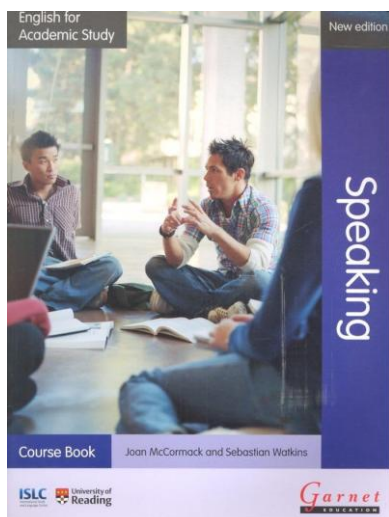
## Ex-Husbands = Ex Maridos – Noah Pritzker

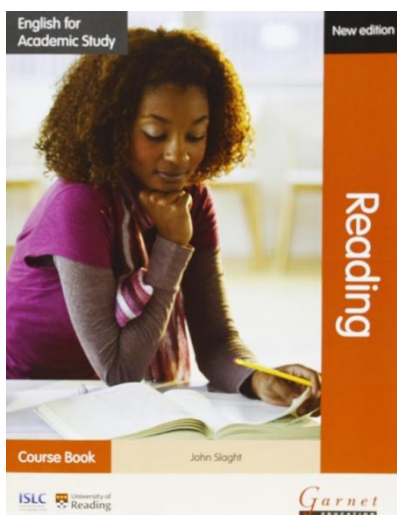

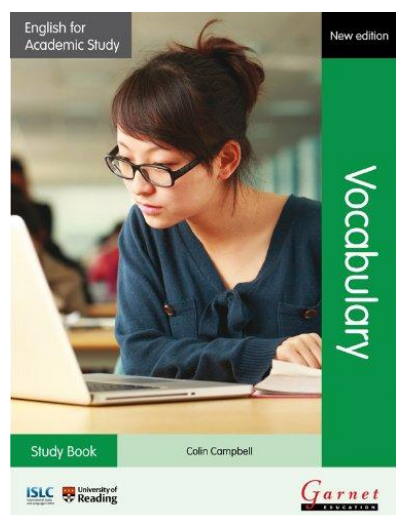

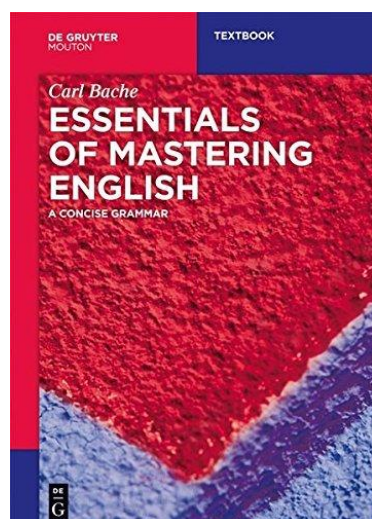
